- Governance **and** Democracy
 - **Relational approach**: How are governance and democracy related?

What did we achieve?

- Clarify different concepts of governance and democracy
- Systematically dwell on the relationship between democracy and governance

 - Differentiate from participatory governance
 - Democratisation as a process
- **Public sphere**
 - The public as different from private and state – a socialized, open, collective, communitarian space
